



Bill Jackson began his TV career in Iowa in 1957, before moving to Chicago television with work at WBBM in Clown Alley and Here Comes Freckles. At WFLD, he launched Cartoon Town and B.J. & Dirty Dragon. He moved to WGN with B.J. and, at WLS, created the successful Gigglesnort Hotel which was syndicated nationally. During the 1980s, he moved west where he taught production at the prestigious California Institute of Arts, begun by Walt Disney.
